### Activity 1 / Name of the module: Culturally responsive teaching techniques

Content	Skills	Competencies
Culturally responsive teaching	- bridge the gap between teacher and student by helping the teacher understand the cultural nuances that may cause a relationship to break down	- empathy - communication - creativity

### Activity General Description and material

SALAD BOWL	
Activity Overview	<i>This game activity helps participants to understand the diversity of culture, with particular regard to different languages. Each participant should guess the meaning of foreign words.</i>
Materials	Pieces of paper, writing tools, a bowl
Duration	30 minutes, mainly depending on the duration of the debriefing
Feasibility	The activity should be carried out with <b>all participants</b> .

### Activity

On pieces of paper, write down in your native language the names of five different objects from your surroundings. Then, all the participants should put the pieces of paper in a “salad bowl” and mix them. Take turns, pick a paper from the bowl and read it out loud. You have to guess the meaning of the word, even if it is in a foreign language.

### Tips/suggestions/best practices for the activity

Look for ways to facilitate the similarities between words. You can ask about the origin of words to find out more, and invite learners to share more.
